

**ORDER NUMBER 5 OF COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER
REQUIRING TESTING OF DETAINED YOUTH AT THE
SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY JUVENILE HALL AND COASTAL VALLEY ACADEMY
DUE TO THE LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY
REGARDING CORONAVIRUS (“COVID-19”)
OCTOBER 28, 2020**

Pursuant to Sections 120175, 120175.5 and 101029 of the California Health and Safety Code, and Section 2501 of Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations, the Health Officer of the County of San Luis Obispo **HEREBY ORDERS** the following:

1. The Health Administrator for the San Luis Obispo County Juvenile Hall and Coastal Valley Academy (“CVA”) camp program, with concurrence from the County Health Officer, shall order the testing of any detained youth at the Juvenile Hall and CVA where there is a reasonable suspicion based on medical criteria that the detained youth may have COVID-19 or if there is a reasonable likelihood that the detained youth was exposed to COVID-19. This shall include the ability to order involuntary testing of any detained youth who refuses to be tested.
2. This Order is issued to protect public health, the health of Juvenile Hall and CVA detained youth, and the health of Juvenile Hall and CVA medical and custodial staff, and to limit the spread of COVID-19 in the Juvenile Hall and CVA.
3. The Declaration of Local Health Emergency related to COVID-19 issued by the undersigned on March 13, 2020 is hereby incorporated by reference in this Order as though fully set forth herein.
4. Pursuant to Section 101029 of the California Health and Safety Code, the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff may enforce this Order for the purpose of preventing the spread of COVID-19 within the Juvenile Hall and CVA and protect the health of Juvenile Hall and CVA detained youth and Juvenile Hall and CVA medical and custodial staff.
5. This Order is effective as of 1:01 p.m. on October 28, 2020 and shall remain in effect until rescinded by the undersigned.
