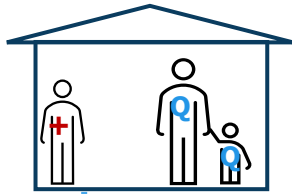


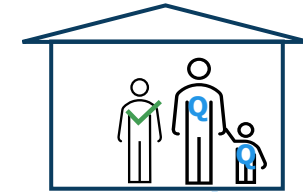
Quarantine Timeline When Someone in Your Home Has COVID-19



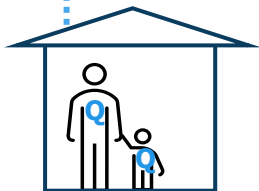
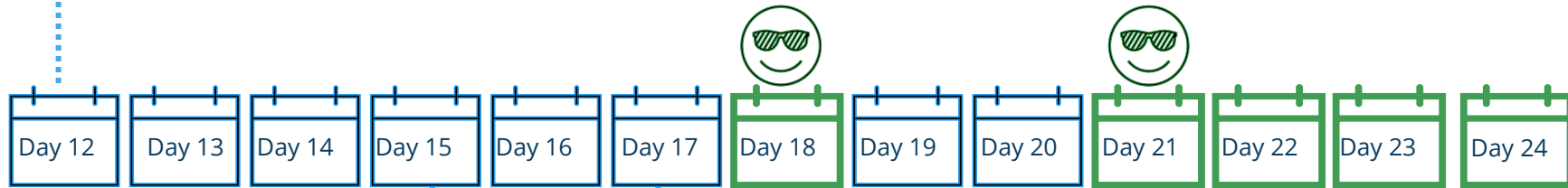
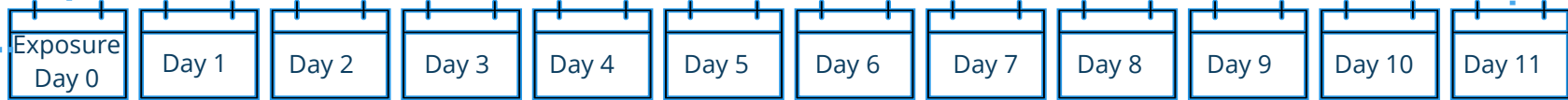

Positive person isolates at home. Others living in home are continuously exposed and must quarantine.



Last day of exposure if positive person no longer infectious and ends isolation on Day 11.

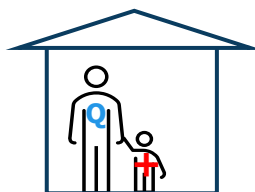


Others at home must quarantine for another 7-10 days

Get tested 5-7 days after last exposure, and if negative, can end quarantine on **Day 18**.

If testing not completed, can end quarantine on **Day 21**.

Continue to monitor for symptoms.



New Exposure— Start over at Day 0 if another member of the home develops symptoms or tests positive, at any time during quarantine period. Get tested immediately if symptomatic.

If Possible, Live Apart to Shorten Quarantine

Other household members may begin their 7 to 10-day quarantine period as soon as they live apart (not in same home) and stay apart until the person with COVID-19 completes their isolation period.
